


Each book in this kit has been hand selected in order to help you, your child's first and best teacher, build positive relationships through reading, talking, singing, playing, and, of course, laughing.

So grab a book, grab your baby, and have fun!


FUN EXAMPLES OF HOW TO SHARE THE BOOKS IN THIS KIT WITH YOUR LITTLE ONE:





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
MAKE IT INTERACTIVE - Many great board books are designed to foster interaction with your baby. So go for it! Use your finger to make this story come alive!






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




IMAGINE - Is it a daisy or a sheep? Talk to your child as you ask questions, imagine possibilities, and discover surprises together.
