



COVID-19 Vaccine Mobile Unit at Meridian Library District, Cherry Lane June 29

The community is invited to get an initial vaccine from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m and 3 to 6 p.m. Tuesday, June 29 at the Meridian Library District, 1326 W. Cherry Lane, Meridian.

- This service and vaccine are free to the patients being vaccinated.
- If able, please bring your insurance card and photo ID. If you do not have these documents, you will still be vaccinated.
- Parents/legal guardians must provide consent for patients under the age of 18. If they are unable to attend the appointment, they can send the minor with a written consent form, or we can obtain verbal consent over the phone.
- **Limited mobility?** Even if you have limited mobility, you can be vaccinated at the mobile unit. Please stay in your vehicle and call 208-513-3413 when you arrive at the vaccination location and we will come to you.
