



## **How to Register Your Child for Kindergarten**

The West Ada School District provides many on-location opportunities to register your child for kindergarten. Registering for kindergarten gives the schools an idea of how many incoming students to expect. It also allows you and your child to walk inside your new school and meet a few of the staff members, which can settle nerves and excite your student about the upcoming school year! Listed below are the items you will need to bring with you to registration at your local school. If you have any more questions about registering children for school, please contact the West Ada School District.

### **Preparing for Kindergarten Registration:**

- Complete the West Ada School District [Online Pre-Registration](#)

Then go to your local school and supply the following documents:

- Birth Certificate
- Immunization Records (5 DTap, 4 Polio, 2 MMR, 3 Hepatitis B, 2 Hepatitis A, 2 Varicella)
- Proof of Address (such as power bill)

Once forms are completed online and your immunizations, birth certificate, and proof of address have been received by the school, then you will be contacted by the school to set up an appointment. Please bring your child with you to the appointment!
